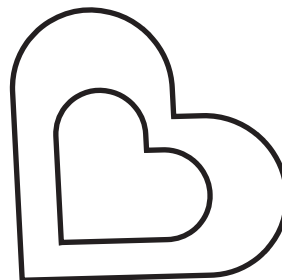
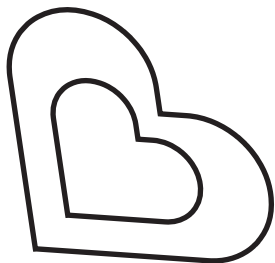
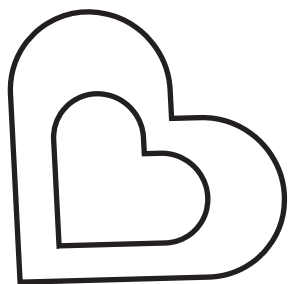


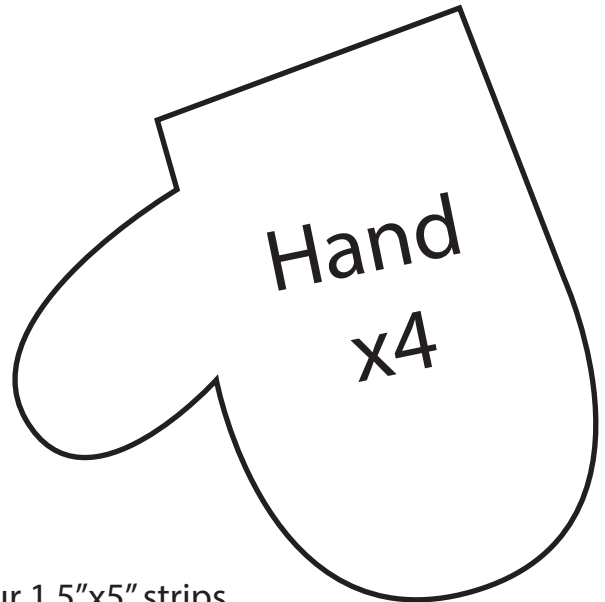
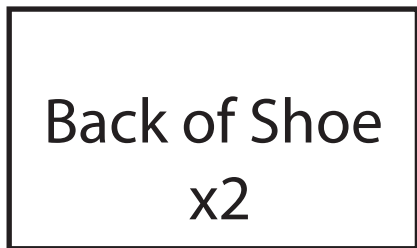
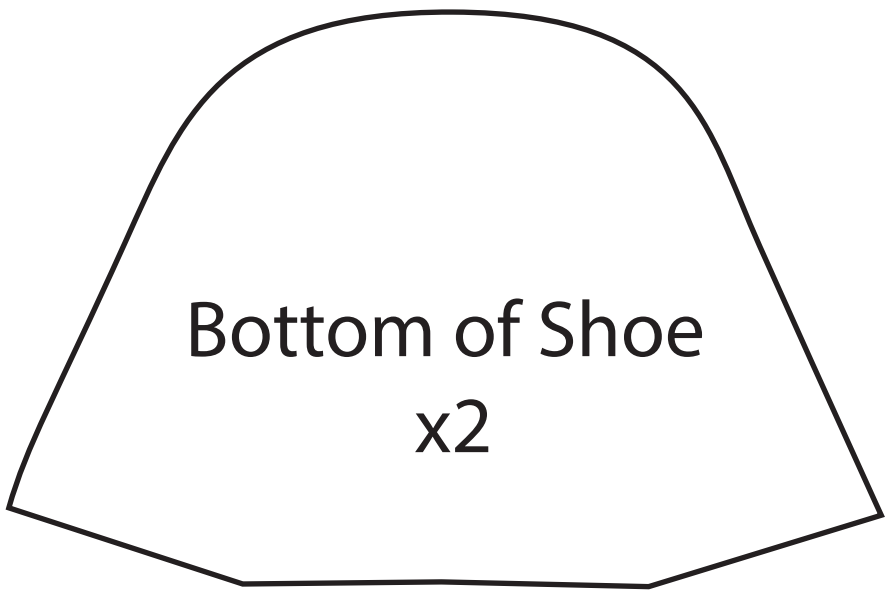
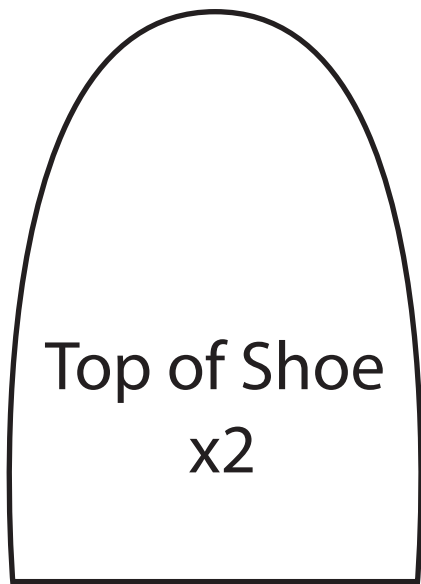
# Huggable Felt Heart Softie

You will also need two 2"x12" strips and four 1.5"x5" strips

1. Cut the paper shapes out.
2. Using the paper shapes as a template, cut the shapes out of felt.



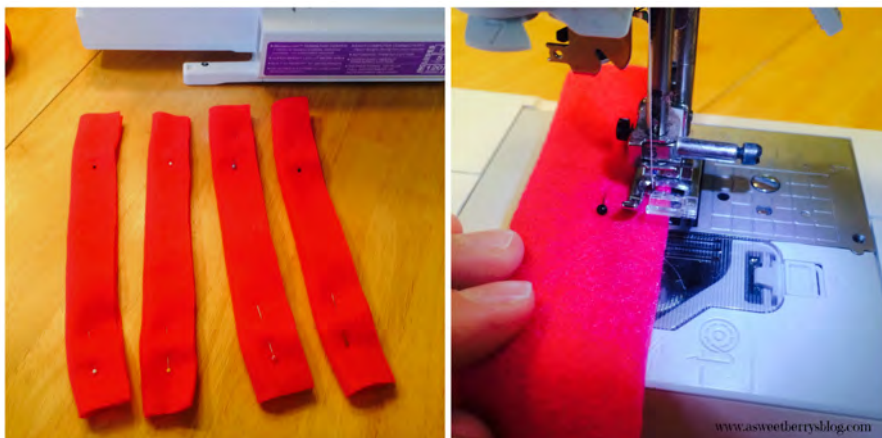
3. Sew together the ends of the two 2"x12" strips.



4. Sew together the hands, leaving the bottoms open. Turn them inside out.



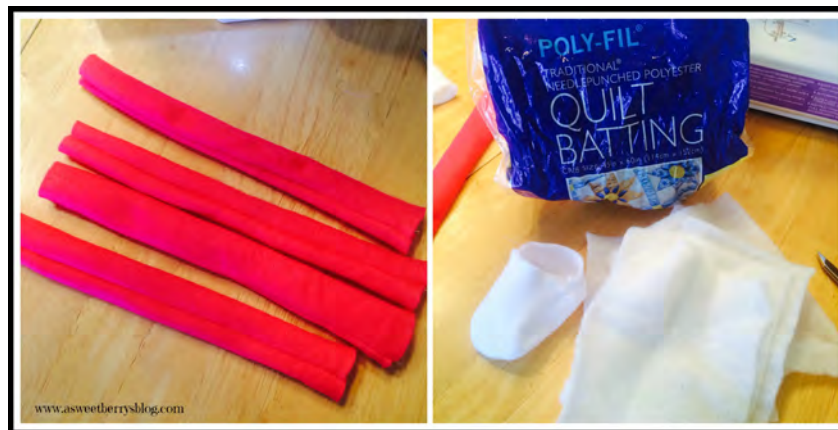
5. Fold the 1.5"x5" strips in half long ways and sew up the seems, leaving the ends open, making four strips. Turn them inside out.



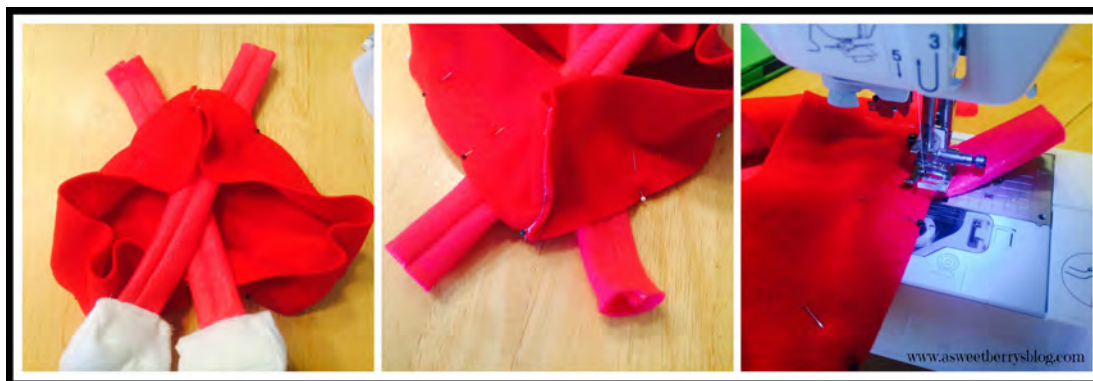
6. This might get a little tricky. With the three shoe pieces, pin them together with the long piece of the rectangle lining up with the half oval shape and pin it. Then line up the three sides of the larger piece to the two ends of the rectangle. Pin the three sides. Now, remove the pin that is holding the half oval piece and the rectangle piece. Sew the ends together that are pinned. Then, turn it inside out.



7. I used Poly-fil quilt batting, but you can use anything to stuff the shoes. Once you have the shoes stuffed, insert one of the long strips and sew across the top of the shoe closing it.

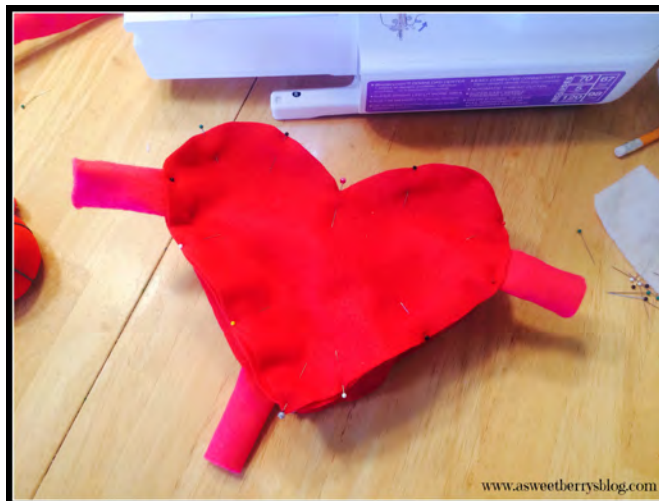


9. Pin the sewn 2"x12" strip to one of the heart pieces. Insert the leg pieces from the inside. I inserted both, but ended up taking one out, so that I could leave a hole to sew it up once it's turned inside out and stuffed. Sew around the heart, leaving about a 2-3 inch opening where one of the legs goes.



10. Using the hands and the last two strips, do the same thing that was done with the foot. Once the hands are stuffed, insert the strip into the hand and sew across the hand to close it up and hold the strip in place.

11. Making use that the foot and leg are inside the back part of the heart, start pinning the front part to the already sewn part, inserting the arms just like with the legs. Sew all the way around the heart. And then turn it inside out.



12. Now there should be two arms/hands and one leg/shoe attached. Now it's time to stuff the heart!

13. Using a needle and red thread, I turned in the edges and sewed him shut!



Once he was all stuffed and sewn up, I used Aleene's Fabric Fusion and added some hearts for eyes and a mouth.
